



# Requirements by Grade Level

## 2011 Freshman Requirements

- Language Arts: 2 semesters of Freshman LA
- Mathematics: 2 semesters
- Coordinated Science: 2 semesters
- Health and Physical Wellness: 1 semester  
3 additional courses required by graduation
- Global Studies: 1 semester
- Fine Arts: 2 semesters required by graduation
- Occupational Education: 2 semesters required by graduation
- Electives: Choices dependent upon other required classes
- Student must be enrolled in 6 classes each sem.
- Advisory

## 2010 Sophomore Requirements

- Language Arts: 2 semesters of Sophomore LA
- Mathematics: 2 semesters
- Health and Physical Wellness: 4 semesters required for graduation
- Science: 2 semesters
- Fine Arts: 2 semesters required by graduation
- Occupational Education: 2 semesters required by graduation
- Include any requirements not successfully completed in grade 9
- Electives: Choices may be based on student's pathway
- Student must be enrolled in 6 classes each sem.
- Advisory

## 2009 Junior Requirements

- Language Arts: 2 semesters of LA. (One must have the word "American" in the title)
- Mathematics: 2 semesters
- U.S. History: 2 semesters- U.S. History I and II
- Fine Arts: 2 semesters required by graduation
- Health and Physical Wellness: 4 semesters required for graduation
- Occupational Education: 2 semesters required by graduation
- Include any requirements not successfully completed in grades 9 and 10
- Teacher signature required for Office/Teacher Assistant
- Electives: Choices which be based on each student's pathway.
- Advisory
- Passed WASL
- Enroll in 6 classes per semester. (1st and 6th period non-scheduled time is permitted if WASL is passed and student on track for graduation, requires parental approval)

## 2008 Senior Requirements

- Language Arts: 2 semesters of Language Arts required ONLY for a 4-year college
- Senior students must register for Culminating Project or a Senior Seminar class.
- Government: 1 semester
- Current World Problems: 1 semester
- Senior Social Studies: 1 semester (Two semesters of SS required for a 4-year college)
- Include any requirements not successfully completed in grades 9-11 (Fine Arts, Occupational Education, and Health and Fitness)
- Electives: Choices may be based on each student's career pathway
- Advisory
- Teacher signature required for Teacher and Office Assistant
- Passed WASL-CAA or CIA
- Enroll in 6 classes per semester. (1st and 6th period non-scheduled time is permitted but requires parental approval)
