

**Central Valley School District**  
***Facilities Options Committee***  
**March 12, 2007**

**CHARGE**

This committee is a representative group of community volunteers who will closely analyze facility options for student housing as the Central Valley School District runs out of space for students. These options may include but not be limited to: multi-track year round school, double-shifting, use of portable classrooms, leased space, running another construction bond and other options as suggested by the community and committee members.

The Facilities Options Committee will be made up of 18-20 community members to include:

- Parents
- Staff
- High School Students
- Broad-based representation of community members
- Additional members as the Board deems necessary

The committee will be led by an independent professional facilitator with the district public information officer serving as liaison. An application process will be implemented and advertised to select committee members.

The Facilities Options Committee will:

- Consider committee member ideas
- Consider community input gathered through three community meetings to be held in mid-April
- Research facilities options
- Identify pros and cons of each option, including resources needed
- Discuss the relevance to CVSD
  - Impact on student learning
  - Impact on student housing
  - Impact on families
- Report findings to Board of Directors by October 2007
