## Student Supply List – 2009-2010

### Kindergarten

1. Glue sticks – 8 (not colored)
  2. Crayola crayons – 2 boxes - 24 count each
  3. Box of Crayola markers – thick
  4. One pink pearl eraser
  5. Large box of Kleenex
  6. Package of napkins or coffee filters
  7. One tub of Wet-Ones or Wipes
  8. 1 ½ inch 3 ring binder with clear pocket on the outside cover (student's name on inside)
  9. Fiskars scissors – blunt
  10. Snack crackers – 1 box any kind
  11. Two plain colored folder with pockets and 3 hole tabs
  12. One folder with bottom pockets
  13. Backpack - large enough to hold 8 ½" x 11" folder \*
- ~ Please write your child's name on the backpack binder and folders only, as other items will be shared.

### First Grade

1. Plastic school box – not larger than 5" x 8"
  2. Glue – 4 oz bottle (orange top) and 4 glue sticks
  3. Crayons – 16-24 count
  4. Markers – 8 thick washable
  5. Pencils – 2 packages of #2 yellow (sharpened)
  6. Pink pearl erasers – 2
  7. Fiskars scissors – blunt
  8. Folders with bottom pockets – Plain (not decorated) 1 each red, blue, green and yellow
  9. Kleenex – large box
  10. Wet wipes – 2 packages
  11. Baggies – 1 box any size
  12. Snack Crackers – 1 box (no peanut products!)
  13. Backpack \*
- ~ Please write your child's name on the backpack only as other items will be shared.

### Second Grade

1. Plastic school box – not larger than 5" x 8"
2. Glue – 2 4 oz bottles and/or 4 glue sticks
3. Crayons – 24 count (Crayola preferred)
4. Markers – 1 box of wide and/or thin
5. Pencils – 2 packages of #2 yellow
6. Fiskars scissors
7. Folders with bottom pockets – Plain (not decorated) 1 each red, blue, green, and yellow
8. 3 composition notebooks (not spiral) approx. 7 ½ x 9 ½
9. Kleenex – 1 large box
10. Wet wipes/baby wipes – 2 package of 40 plus sheets
11. Zip Lock bags (snack or gallon)
12. Backpack \*

### Third Grade

1. Plastic school box
2. Glue – white school glue bottle or 2 glue sticks
3. Crayons – 24 count (Crayola preferred)
4. Markers or colored pencils
5. Highlighter
6. Pencils – 3 packages of 12 - #2 yellow
7. Erasers – 1 pkg of pencil top and/or 1 pink pearl
8. Fiskars scissors (continued in next column ~)

### Third Grade (continued)

9. Wooden ruler with metric and standard units. No rubber or plastic rulers.
10. Folders w/bottom pockets – 1 each red, blue, yellow, green, purple
11. Paper – 2 packages of college-ruled
12. Spiral notebook – 2
13. Kleenex – 2 boxes to share with class
14. Wet wipes or 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
15. Baggies – 1 box, any size

### Fourth Grade

1. Plastic school box
  2. Glue – white school glue or 2 glue sticks
  3. Crayons
  4. Markers – 1 box colored fine point
  5. Markers – 1 box black fine point
  6. Highlighter -yellow
  7. Dry erase markers – 2 black only
  8. Colored pencils – 1 package
  9. Wooden #2 pencils – 1 package
  10. Fiskars scissors – sharp
  11. Wooden ruler with metric and standard units. No rubber or plastic rulers.
  12. Paper – 3 packages of college ruled
  13. Spiral notebook – 2 college ruled
  14. Clipboard
  15. Kleenex – 2 boxes
  16. Backpack – no wheels \*
  17. One 2" three-ring binder
  18. Binder dividers ("write-on" type) – 1 packet
  19. Hand sanitizer – 1 bottle
- ~ Please DO NOT buy fancy, padded binders – no storage

### Fifth Grade

1. Glue – white school glue
  2. Glue sticks
  3. Colored pencils – at least 12 pack
  4. Felt-tip markers – fine tip
  5. Dry erase markers – 3 recommended
  6. Pencils – 12 #2 (mechanical or regular)
  7. Erasers - pencil
  8. Pens – 2 ballpoint (not gel pens)
  9. Sharp scissors
  10. Ruler with metric and standard units
  11. Calculator (scientific calculator is not necessary)
  12. Binder – 2" metal rings with dividers
  13. Pencil pouch for binder
  14. Paper – college ruled (to be replenished as needed)
  15. Spiral notebooks – 2 plain
  16. Kleenex – 2 large boxes
  17. Highlighters – 2
  18. Optional – thumb drive/flash drive on lanyard
- ~ Student planners will be provided by McDonald Elementary.

**\* We recommend purchasing SMALL sturdy backpacks WITHOUT WHEELS that will fit in an 8" x 13" cubbie.**
