



Colonial Trip Reminders!

May 26-28, 2009

- Please arrive at Summit by 6:30 a.m. on Tuesday, May 26; the bus departs at 7:00
- All students, chaperones and on-site volunteers will need to bring a sack lunch for Tuesday, May 26th. Please provide your child with a hearty snack to be eaten mid morning **and** a lunch.
- Please review camp expectations with your child. If camp expectations are violated or your child demonstrates significant behavior problems while at camp, you may be called to come pick up your child.

Remember!

- ✓ Students may not bring electronic devices of any kind...including BUT NOT LIMITED TO: radios, Ipods, MP3 players, cell phones, electronic games and any other electronic gadgets, etc.
- ✓ Final arrangements must be made before Thursday, May 21 for all chaperones and volunteers. **Only those adults who have made previous arrangements** and completed volunteer packets will be able to attend the trip.

You will need to bring the following:

- ~ Sleeping bag in a plastic bag (both the plastic bag and sleeping bag **labeled with your child's name** with masking tape and sharpie marker)
- ~ pillow (pillow and sleeping bag in a plastic garbage bag-**labeled with name**)
- ~ one or two pairs of comfortable walking shoes (for hiking)
- ~ two pairs of pants
- ~ two sweatshirts
- ~ three shirts (at least one long sleeved, which would be great for layering)
- ~ three pairs of socks
- ~ undergarments
- ~ toothbrush and toiletries (toothbrush, brush/comb-no blowdryers or curling irons)
- ~ towel-**labeled with name** (there are private showers available)
- ~ washcloth with plastic bag so it does not get other clothes wet
- ~ raincoat or large plastic garbage bag (in case of rainy weather)
- ~ plastic grocery bag for dirty or wet clothes (**labeled with name**)
- ~ flashlight- **labeled with name**
- ~ **refillable water bottle -labeled with name**
- ~ coat-it is usually 10-15 degrees cooler up at Shoshone base camp than in the Spokane area.
- ~ colonial clothing; we will provide a tri-corn hat for the boys. They should wear jeans tucked into long black socks and a white button down shirt. The girls should wear a cotton t-shirt, draw string-skirt (over jeans is fine) and we will provide a bonnet and scarf. Girls may also choose to dress in the boys uniform of jeans tucked into black socks and a white buttoned down shirt.

It would be helpful if you labeled anything/everything you send with your child.

Your child should arrive at school on Tuesday morning with three items:

- A plastic garbage bag containing their sleeping bag and pillow
- A travel bag containing their clothing and supplies.
- A lunch and snack for Tuesday.
