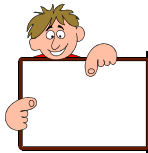
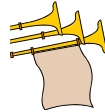

Word Study Investigations

- _____ 3. Decide on five spelling words that are difficult for you and record them on the spelling study sheet (if you have not completed this in class).
- _____ 4. Monday-Thursday write your spelling words on your word study sheet.
- _____ 5. Read 20 minutes per night.
- _____ 6. Have your planner checked and signed.
