Funds Request: None

Minutes: Minutes of the June 1, 2009 meeting read by members. Debbie Davis motioned to approve the minutes; and Ken VanSickle seconded. Minutes approved.

Treasurer's Report: Mary Bestick explained that some of our funds come from Yoke's script and Albertsons. The balance is currently \$5,036.51. We have received proceeds from one volleyball game (\$240.00) and \$1,300.00 was taken out for change at the concession booths.

Committee Reports:

Staff Appreciation: Betsy Frame wants to get the students involved in staff appreciation events. The first staff appreciation will be 2 weeks from Friday (October 2, 2009), which is Homecoming. She passed out both a handout of what is needed and a sign-up sheet for volunteers to fill those needs.

Concessions: Debbie Davis jubilantly announced that all of the concession slots for the Fall season are filled. Debbie explained how the new system works: All sports and clubs are invited to work specific games/events. Each sport/club designates a parent representative, who must hold a current health card and is responsible for obtaining the necessary group of volunteers. That list of volunteers is to be delivered to Debbie at least one week before the game/event.

In order to train new volunteers, Debbie will have three training dates in October.

The JV Volleyball league event will be manned by the Boosters.

New popcorn machine needs to be returned as it is too small for our purposes.

In the past, the Boosters received donation of the popcorn machines and hot dog machine. Debbie will contact past donors and ask if they are willing to continue helping. Debbie would like a large calligraphy 'thank you' sign in the concession stand to acknowledge such donations.

Membership: Mary reported that 14 multiple year memberships and 13 single memberships have been received.

Hospitality: DK reports that not only do the cookies remain popular, but they do not require plates or forks. She will have 42 dozen cookies and punch for the back to school night on September 28, 2009.

Clothing: Karla asked for volunteers for back to school night. Volunteers are to be in place by 6:15 and clothing sales and memberships will be offered until it is time for everyone to move to the gym. At that time everyone at the table will be able to buy clothing and then the clothing will be locked up and volunteers are released.

There are several prints and pins left over from the grand opening of University HS 8 years ago. Debbie Davis made a motion that pins be given to new members and that prints be available at no cost on back to school night. David DeVlemming seconded. Motion carried.

New Business:

Ken VanSickle gave us a heads-up that this year all of the high schools in the state are up for reclassification. Early numbers suggest that only Lewis & Clark and Central Valley high schools will meet the 4A classification. Once the reclassifications are determined, if University HS is classified 3A, the coaches, parents, etc. will review whether it is beneficial to elect to play as 4A. Every two years the state high schools go through the reclassification process.
