Gymnastics equipment is very expensive and U-High has the best equipped high school program in the League. We have excellent training tools for our program, spectacular matting and great technology. All of this costs money. While there is a generous budget allotted to gymnastics it does not begin to pay for the level of equipment we want for our gymnasts. Therefore, we do conduct fundraising with parent involvement.

Some potential fundraising activities may be:

The booster club at U-High is offering concession time to school groups. The gymnastics parents may run the concession stand for other sporting events (not including gymnastics meets). Only adults are allowed to work concessions. The team captain will contact gymnasts who will in turn ask parents to assist. Please make yourself available for these activities.

Hosting of club meets may be conducted in the months of February through May. This involves the use of the Uhigh gymnastics equipment and the gymnasts will be expected to assist with setting up and tearing down the gym as well as other potential money raising activities during these club meets.

We don't sell any products. We don't ask our girls to go door to door for fundraising. We don't ask the families to purchase anything. But we do require all parents to help with these easy events.

ALSO – The U-High Booster Club is a parent run organization that has financially supported the gymnastics program with thousands of dollars. In return, it is the expectation of the coaches that all parents assist with concession sales for events other than gymnastics.
