If you have electrical needs, please send in your contract soon, as these spaces do go quickly. Tables will also be available for rent if you need them. Folding chairs will be provided free of charge.

Our booth rental fee will remain at \$50.00 this year. We will again be offering an exciting incentive to our vendors. If you bring in a friend that was not a vendor at last year's fair, you will be eligible for a \$20.00 refund on your booth rental fee. Refunds will be payable at the end of this year's craft fair.
